18th Antarctica Marathon & Half-Marathon Top Winners

Mother Nature cooperated with perfect weather for the 18th Antarctica Marathon & Half-Marathon held on King George's Island in the South Shetland Islands of Antarctica on March 10 and 11. The events were run in two waves on consecutive days with a total of 185 runners from 17 countries. Included in this count were five half-marathon participants from the Chinese staff of the Great Wall Base and the Chilean staff from Frei Base.

The first wave of runners hosted on board the Akademik Sergei Vavilov Ship started at 8:45 AM on Friday, March 10. Winds were mild with temperatures at 35F under mostly cloudy skies. The second day, runners hosted on the Akademik Ioffe Ship ran under similar conditions. Both days produced ideal conditions for running on this challenging course.

Luan Huynh of Aalborg Ost, Denmark led from the start on day two to claim victory in a time of 3:24:22. The women's title was claimed by Lesley Mettler Auld, age 45, from Seattle, WA with a time of 4:06:14 finishing in tenth place overall. David Sundstrom, age 39, from Karlstad, Sweden was the second blind runner to complete in the events by finishing the half-marathon over rough and hilly terrain in a time of 2:26:50.
